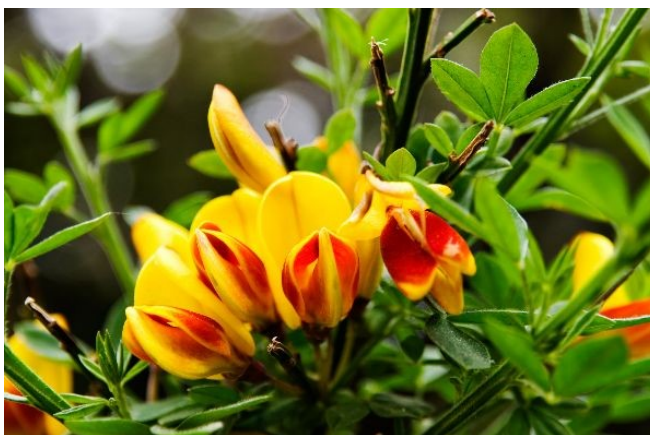

The *Kimono: Kyoto to Catwalk* Exhibition at the Victoria & Albert Museum in London reveals kimono from 1660s to present day, both in Japan and in the rest of the world. The kimono's recent reinvention on the streets of Japan is also explored through work by an exciting new wave of contemporary designers and stylists.
